Notes: Most of our silver flies are weighted, either by wrapped lead wire mid-way on the shank of the hook, or by coneheads, beadeyes or dumbbell eyes. The amount of weight is determined by the type of water you will be fishing silvers and what type of action you prefer. It's always good to have a variety of weights and sizes to change up the action & presentation depth. Silvers will come up for flies, so always have some non-weighted streamers that can be fished just under the surface. Surface flies such as the Gurgler above are mandatory to trigger the most aggressive fish each time you fish a new pool.
