SAMPLE 4-DAY ITINERARY

WILDERNESS + GLACIERS + WILDLIFE

DAY 1 - FLY-IN LODGE + GUIDED FISHING

Depart Anchorage around 10:30 AM by floatplane for a scenic 70-mile flight to Wilderness Place Lodge. Enjoy a chef-prepared lunch, then spend the afternoon fishing with your personal guide. Finish with a four-course dinner, Alaska beer and wine, and an overnight in your private riverside cabin.

DAY 2 - FULL DAY ON THE WATER

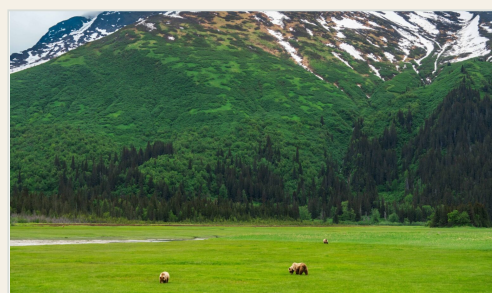
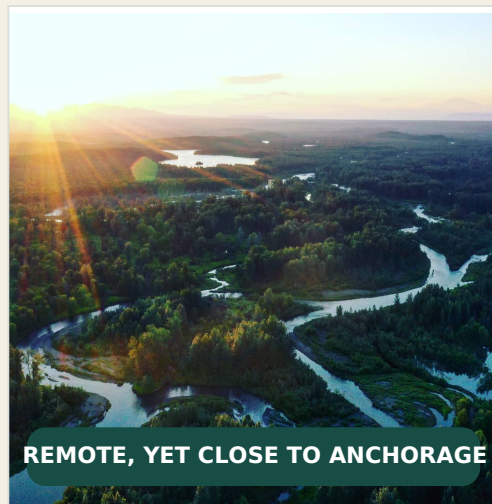
Customize a full day of fishing and wilderness exploration. Fish the river or nearby lake chain for trout, Arctic grayling, northern pike or seasonally available salmon. Breakfast and lunch can be enjoyed at the lodge or on the water, followed by another four-course dinner and cabin overnight.

DAY 3 - GLACIER HELICOPTER EXPERIENCE

Optional morning fishing, then depart the lodge around 11:45 AM for Anchorage. Transfer to your Anchorage hotel and continue to Alaska Glacier Lodge for the Grand Knik Glacier helicopter and photography experience, including multiple glacier landings, glacier walking and dramatic mountain views. Return to Anchorage for your included hotel night and meals.

DAY 4 - LAKE CLARK BEAR VIEWING

Depart Anchorage by floatplane for Chinitna Bay in Lake Clark National Park and Preserve. Spend the morning observing Alaska brown bears in their natural coastal habitat with a professional guide, with spectacular flightseeing and photography along the way. Return to Anchorage around 1:30 PM; plan commercial flights no earlier than 5:00 PM.



WHAT IS INCLUDED

- Floatplane transportation from Anchorage
- Guided fishing, rods/tackle, waders and boots
- Private lodge cabin + Anchorage hotel
- Lodge meals, beer and wine; hotel meal allowance
- Helicopter glacier tour + bear-viewing excursion
- Ground transportation between included activities

GOOD TO KNOW

Activity level: easy to moderate. Expect boarding floatplanes and helicopters, light river wading, glacier walking and short periods on uneven terrain.
