THE ADVENTURE

Combine a remote fly-in stay at Wilderness Place Lodge with native rainbow trout and Arctic grayling fishing, topwater northern pike, a scenic floatplane flight to the historic Pioneer Cabin outpost, and a guided five-mile fishing raft float. Round-trip air from Anchorage, private cabins, chef-prepared meals, gear and guiding are bundled into one easy early-summer adventure.



WHY JUNE + EARLY JULY?

- Nearly 24 hours of usable daylight
- Excellent trout and Arctic grayling opportunities
- Aggressive topwater northern pike in nearby lakes
- Long, flexible days for fishing, flying and exploring

SAMPLE 4-DAY / 3-NIGHT ITINERARY

DAY 1 - FLY IN + FISH

Scenic floatplane from Anchorage to Wilderness Place Lodge. Settle into your private cabin, enjoy lunch, then fish Lake Creek for trout and Arctic grayling. Return for appetizers and chef-prepared dinner.

DAY 2 - RIVER + LAKE VARIETY

A full guided day tailored to conditions: wade fish clear river channels for native trout and grayling, or target northern pike with topwater flies and lures. Enjoy a shore or lodge lunch.

DAY 3 - PIONEER FLY-OUT + FLOAT

Floatplane to the remote Pioneer Cabin lake outpost. Explore the cabin and lake country, enjoy a fireside shore lunch, then launch on a guided five-mile fishing raft float through wild Alaska scenery.

DAY 4 - MORNING FISH + FLY OUT

Breakfast and a final fishing session before your scheduled floatplane return to Anchorage. Longer 4- and 5-night packages add more full fishing days and flexibility.

Sample sequencing is flexible and may change for weather, water conditions and aircraft logistics.
